Adventure awaits

When William the Conqueror saw these acres of deer-filled heathland, pretty glades and wild wood more than 900 years ago, he couldn't believe his luck.

The New Forest was to become a royal playground, set aside for the hunting of deer, jealously guarded and preserved, for the lucky few to enjoy.

There is probably more woodland now than in William's time, but the wonderful open spaces, forest glades and peaceful walks remain largely unchanged.

Above all, the atmosphere of this ancient landscape is one of perfect peace and tranquility. You'll give way to ponies and cattle, grazing freely as they have done for centuries, while deep in the wooded areas you'll see deer, browsing under the canopies of mighty oaks.

Visitors come to the New Forest to enjoy a break from the frantic pace of life; they leave with the sense of a place unmoved by the centuries and where the natural beauty is undiminished by the demands of time.





Forest fun

Frolic through bluebell woods, watch new born foals in the spring, or laze on hot summer days under the canopy of mighty ancient oaks (some were around in Henry VIII's time). Brilliantly coloured leaves and chance encounters with pannage pigs in the autumn to crisp, clear winter walks over gorse-coated heaths. The forest is great fun all year round.



Towns & villages Here you can find everything from

Here you can find everything from legends concerning dragons, witches and smuggling to cobbled quays, fishing boats, ferries; the forest's towns & villages are all unique. Medieval stone bridges spanning lazy rivers, narrow streets lined with picturesque cottages and market squares full of every conceivable type of shop, provide a kaleidoscope of interesting and relaxing days out.

Managing the forest Habitats The New Forest may seem New Forest Habitats

The New Forest may seem like a wild place if you travel through it and don't take a closer look.

But like most of our cherished woodlands and forests, they are managed. This long history of management for fuel and other forest products has created the diverse habitats that you see today, and where wildlife thrives.

Today, the Crown lands of the New Forest (nearly half of the National Park area) are managed and maintained by the Forestry Commission for people, wildlife and timber.



Working Forest:

Stay safe by taking note of warning signs and keeping away from work sites and vehicles.

Timber inclosures

The forest industry in the New Forest dates back to the first inclosure in 1483. Timber being produced was of national value for the shipbuilding industry. Today, timber production is centred on 9,000 hectares which are enclosed from grazing animals, producing 50,000m³ of timber each year.

Open forest

The open forest covers two thirds of the New Forest Crown lands and is made up of a variety of habitats including forest 'lawns' (open, grassy areas), valley mires (boggy habitats), heathland and Ancient and Ornamental woodlands. These habitats have been sustained by grazing, burning and the gathering of bracken, heathers and turves by many generations. Today, the Forestry Commission undertakes many of these traditional activities to secure the future of heathland. Work includes controlled burning, gorse cutting and bracken harvesting as well as restoration of valley mires and removing invasive species, such as rhododendron.

Woodland rides

Woodland 'rides' (open pathways) allow access for machinery but are also important for recreation and conservation. An active programme of ride restoration has seen the re-establishment of forest flora and an increase in insects, small mammals and birds of prey over recent years. Each year, a programme of ride restoration is put together to ensure that any damage made by forestry machinery is rectified as soon as conditions allow.

Architects of the forest

You will find five kinds of animals roaming free across the open forest: ponies, cattle, donkeys, sheep and pigs.

The open forest looks like it does because their eating and trampling keep the habitats in good condition. New Forest Ponies are often referred to as "the architects of the forest" as their grazing patterns and browsing habits have created the environment that you see today.

There are about 700 commoners who own the animals - each commoner owns or rents land to which Rights of Common are attached, including the right to graze stock on the open forest.

You can tell who owns the ponies as each commoner has a brand, often inherited from their family, which you can see on the pony's hip, shoulder or saddle.

Each pony tends to stay in one area, which we call a haunt. Here it finds all the natural food it needs.

Ponies, donkeys, cattle & pigs

For their safety and your own please leave the animals alone - they should be treated as wild. Please don't feed or pet them; although owned and cared for by local people called commoners, there is plenty of natural food and it's best that they don't come to rely on people's attention. They may look friendly but they can bite and kick, especially mares with foals.

Driving

The ponies and other animals have no road sense and frequently stand or walk on the unfenced roads, so give them a wide berth and be especially careful when driving at night.

Litter

Your food and litter could harm the ponies and donkeys. Please take your litter home if bins are full.

IT'S THE LAW: Report all accidents

involving a pony, cow, donkey, dog, pig or sheep to the Police as soon as possible, and within 24 hours.

Walking... where will you explore today?

Follow our waymarked walks and trails

The following trails are marked on the ground by wooden marker posts with coloured bands. An overview map of each route is displayed at the start point in the Forestry Commission car park. All routes are circular and will bring you back to your starting point. Numbers refer to map



L Dogs:

To minimise disturbance to wildlife, livestock and other people, please keep your dogs close by you and visible at all times – if necessary use a lead. Pick up after your dog, especially around car parks, on paths and where people play or picnic, and take bagged waste home if there is no litter bin.

Ticks:

Check your dog and yourself for ticks when you get back - they can lead to Lyme Disease.

2. From Bolderwood car park:

Deer Watch Trail

0.75km/0.5 miles

A short stroll leading you to a deer viewing platform overlooking fields where wild herds of fallow deer are regularly seen. The path is a moderately smooth gravelled surface with gentle slopes and benches along the way. The trail is accessed by a gate which has a low catch.

Jubilee Grove Trail

1.5km/1 mile

Including the deer fields, this meandering route leads you past some majestic trees, the oldest of which date back to 1860. Benches from which to admire their beauty can be found along the way. The path is a moderately smooth gravelled surface with two short but fairly steep slopes and frequent resting places. The trail is accessed via a gate which has a low catch.

Radnor Trail

3km/2 miles

A longer route which takes you into the heart of the forest and across the Bratley Water stream, Benches and picnic benches are located along the trail. The path is a moderately smooth gravelled surface with two short but fairly steep slopes and frequent resting places. The trail is accessed via a gate which has a low catch.



To avoid damage and obstruction, please park only in designated car parks, not on a verge or in gateways. Lock your car, taking any valuables with you and leave Forestry Commission car parks by dusk.

6. From Blackwater or Brockhill car parks:

Tall Trees Trail

2.5km/1.5 miles

Follow the marker posts and you will be guided on a shady path beneath mighty Douglas firs and redwoods that were planted during the reign of Queen Victoria. The path has a fairly smooth gravelled surface. The trail is flat with frequent resting places and no gates.

Blackwater Arboretum Trail

0.75km/0.5 miles

A circular route which leads you past tree species from around the world. By following instructions on the unique panels, you can use your senses to discover the secrets that these trees hold. Benches are located along the walk. The path has a fairly smooth gravelled surface with one very gentle slope.

7. Whitefield Moor or Puttles Bridge car parks:

Ober Water Trails

1.5km/1 mile (red trail)
2.5km/1.5 miles (yellow trail)
Two circular routes follow the Ober
Water midway between its source
and the sea. Close to this meandering
stream is the open, grassy expanse
of Whitefield Moor. The paths are
moderately smooth gravelled surfaces
and compacted grassy ground with
some gentle slopes and few resting
places. Can be muddy after wet
weather.

3. Reptile Centre car park Reptile Trail

2km/1.5 miles

Enjoy a circular walk through the woods. The trail mainly follows a fairly smooth gravelled surface although the final section is a grassy path that can become muddy during wet weather. Please note that part of this trail is on a cycle route.

8. Wilverley car parks

Wilverley Wander

4.2km/2.5 miles

A longer and more informal trail which winds through this diverse and working woodland. The paths are moderately smooth gravelled surfaces with some short, steep slopes. Please note that part of this trail is on a cycle route.

5. Knightwood car park

Knightwood Oak

Less than 0.25 miles
A short stroll to one of the most famous trees in the New Forest. Believed to have been planted before 1600, this tree is still going strong and is a spectacular example of the ancient practice of pollarding. Benches are located throughout. The path has a fairly smooth gravelled surface.

Cycling...

we've got the trails, are you ready to ride?

Our network of more than 100 miles of waymarked family-friendly cycle routes is off the public highway and traffic-free.

The network is easily accessible from railway stations at Ashurst, Brockenhurst and Sway and links the main New Forest villages.

There are plenty of places to hire bikes before and during your stay.

Cycling:

Cycling is allowed only on the waymarked tracks and other designated routes. When approaching people and animals, call out a warning and pass slowly and wide. Try to leave gaps for overtaking vehicles and never ride more than two abreast. Keep to a safe speed, wear bright colours to be visible and always use lights in the dark.

Follow the New Forest Cycle Code

The New Forest is a working forest, with forestry, farming and equestrian activity on its narrow roads and tracks.

Off-road cycling in the New Forest is permitted only on certain routes.

Cycle Map and Code

Horse-riding in the New Forest

The New Forest is a wonderful place to go horse-riding. You can walk quietly through magnificent oak woods, past tall conifers, or stride across the heathland enjoying the views and the open forest.

Horse-riders have always enjoyed open access in the forest, which is well furnished with suitable tracks.

When leaving Forestry Commission land, remember to use the bridleways provided. On private land, riders must keep to public Rights of Way. These are shown on Ordnance Survey maps, and are usually indicated by fingerposts and/or blue arrows or dots.

Horse-riding:

Horse-riders have open access to the New Forest, but to reduce damage to the ground please use tracks when it's wet.

If you're looking for wildlife in the New Forest, you're sure to see something if you visit the New Forest Reptile Centre. Specially created enclosures allow you to safely study the reptiles and amphibians of the New Forest. There are also opportunities to see birds of prey up close on nest-cams through the 'A date with nature' project. Open Easter until end of September, this site also includes a waymarked walking trail and woodland picnic area.

The Deer Viewing Platform at Bolderwood offers the chance to see these normally secretive animals in the wild. Mainly Fallow deer gather here to feed and they can often be seen at very close quarters during the summer months.






Whether it's enjoying a riverside picnic, exploring the charming High Street or visiting the worldfamous motor museum, the village of Beaulieu is a great day out.

Situated at the head of the Beaulieu River, the village dates back to the 13th century when the village grew up around the abbey, founded in 1204 by Cistercian monks on land given to them by King John, who had a royal hunting lodge at Beaulieu.

Following Henry VIII's dissolution of the monasteries in the 1530s, Beaulieu passed into the ownership of the present Lord Montagu's ancestors and has remained with the family ever since. The last Lord Montagu of Beaulieu founded Britain's National Motor Museum, which houses more than 250 vehicles and includes legendary motor vehicles from all over the world, including the record-breaking Bluebird

In the village of Beaulieu, visitors can find an interesting variety of village shops, ranging from specialist gift and chocolate shops to art and craft. Venture down the road and spend a pleasant day out at historic Buckler's Hard, a pretty shipbuilding village along the Beaulieu River.
