Kaziranga National Park is the greatest preserve of rhinos on Earth with 2,400+ in one park along with elephants, tigers, wild buffaloes, freshwater dolphins and over 472 species of birds. When we had hosted the Trustees of National Geographic there, they had called the Kaziranga National Park as the Serengeti of India! Also visit temples, monasteries, tribal and weaver's villages, tea plantations on the cruise.

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I felt like Katherine Hepburn in the “African Queen”. What a wonderful experience. The staff was exceptional. I thoroughly enjoyed it.



Route Map of M.V. Mahabaahu on the river Brahmaputra, Assam *not to scale*




Day 1 (Sunday) ARRIVE JORHAT & BOARD MV MAHABAAHU

On arrival at the Jorhat Airport, we will be met in the receiving area and drive to Neamati Ghat to board the MV Mahabaahu. After the essential safety briefing enjoy the first sail and scan the river for a fleeting sight of the Gangetic Dolphins. Evening talk on 'Sibsagar and the Ahom Civilization'.

Day 2 (Monday) NEAMATI GHAT / SIBSAGAR VISIT / TEA ESTATE HOME HOSTED LUNCH

After an early breakfast, we start our day-excursion to Sibsagar. Thereafter, we drive to a Tea Estate for a relaxed afternoon where we enjoy a traditional Assamese lunch with the Tea-estate family.

Day 3 (Tuesday) MAJULI VISIT / MISHING VILLAGE VISIT

After Yoga, as we have our breakfast. We sail towards the Majuli.

We get on the tenders and arrive on the mainland where a drive takes us to a scenic corner of a Satra for an interesting cultural and performance by Satriya singers dancers. Next, we drive to Kamalabari Satra to witness the Vaishnavite priests dancing to the rhythm of cymbals, drums and chanting in the temple premise.



We enjoy hot lunch on MV Mahabaahu and sail towards the closest Mishing Village.

After the Mishing Village, MV Mahabaahu heads towards Dhansiri Mukh where the waters of Brahmaputra and Dhansiri meet, while we enjoy a talk on 'Assam, its geographical location & importance'. We then enjoy the evening under the stars on a deserted island

Day 4 (Wednesday) SAILS TOWARDS THE EASTERN RANGE OF KAZIRANGA

After Yoga and an early morning walk on a deserted island, MV Mahabaahu sails towards the Eastern Range of Kaziranga for boat Safari. We enjoy breakfast and a talk on 'The River Brahmaputra and the life that exists alongside'. We proceed for the safari in our tenders for about two hours. This evening we enjoy the Chef's Cooking Demonstration followed by a talk on 'Majuli'. The evening on a deserted island with bonfire is always unusual.


Day 5 (Thursday) **WEAVERS VILLAGE AT BISHWANATH GHAT / WESTERN RANGE OF KAZIRANGA NATIONAL PARK.**

After Yoga/walk on the deserted island and breakfast, we enjoy an interesting talk on 'Kaziranga and the wild life in India'. Then we step into our tenders to go to the shores of Bishwanath Ghat. We enjoy a walk through the village and see how this suburban village thrives.

We sail on for the next couple of hours and enjoy a relaxed lunch and reach Silghat. We take a drive from Silghat to the Western Range of the Kaziranga National Park for an exhilarating jeep safari through the world's largest population of single horned rhinos, wild buffaloes, elephants, deers and hundreds of species of birds.

Day 6 (Friday) KAZIRANGA NATIONAL PARK / SAIL

Very early today drive towards the Kaziranga National Park. Start our morning adventure with once-in-a-lifetime elephant safari. After breakfast at a resort in Kaziranga, we get into the open jeeps for some more wildlife adventure and an extensive coverage of this magnificent park.

Return to MV Mahabaahu

After the leisurely pace of the day and having recovered the lost sleep, we once again get together for A talk on 'Kamakhya and the Occult and Peacock the Island' and then proceed for traditional Assamese theme dinner.

Day 7 (Saturday) A VILLAGE VISIT / FULL DAY SAIL / PEACOCK ISLAND

We catch up on Yoga on an island or on the deck for an hour and move on to breakfast, while MV Mahabaahu lifts anchor and heads on towards an island that is occupied predominantly by a Bangla speaking Muslim community who are involved in extensive farming. After a visit to this village we return to the ship for lunch and sail towards the Peacock Island. After the Peacock island visit, we sail towards Pandu Port and anchor at a jetty. We get ready for the Farewell Dinner 'Alvida Bhoj' and enjoy a relaxed evening.

Day 8 (Sunday) GUWAHATI / KAMAKHYA TEMPLE VISIT / DEPARTURE

Early morning Yoga or Nature walk. Post breakfast, disembark the cruise to Guwahati airport with en-route stop at the Kamakhya Temple.

WEATHER AND SEASONAL INFORMATION:

There are four distinct seasons in Assam - summer, monsoon, autumn and winter. The best time to visit Assam is in the autumn and winter seasons, i.e. from October to April, which is also the festive season of Assam. While winter days are usually sunny, the temperature can fall to 8 degrees Celsius (46 F) at night. Our cabins are air conditioned and heated for your comfort, but you should include warm clothing, hats and jackets in your packing when visiting during the winter months. Kaziranga National Park is open from 15th October until the 30th of April. During the first half of October and May, the Park has a "Partially Open" status which means that the Park will be open but that not all roads may be navigable as they work to restore them to pre monsoon standards. Please note, there are no elephant-backed or jeep safaris between May and the first half of October. Boat safaris will be offered instead during these months. During the months that the Kaziranga National Park is closed, we are able to explore the shores of the Park with our expedition boats. We will cruise the Park shoreline and many of the riverine islands that are home to a number of animals and a wide variety of birds. During the peak winter season of mid-December to mid-February, the itinerary will be adjusted according to daylight hours as the M.V. Mahabaahu does not sail during darkness. In order to provide for full coverage of the Kaziranga National Park during these winter months, we will not visit Bishwanath Ghat.

RIVER CONDITIONS AND DISCLAIMER:

River cruising in this part of the world is an adventurous experience. Assam is still in the developing stages of tourism and the developing infrastructure is rushing to keep pace with the rapidly growing interest in this part of India. As such, our voyage is an expedition-style cruise with all creature comforts on-board. Our shore-side staff will make every effort to attend to your comfort during onshore expeditions. However, vehicles and roads may not be of the same standard that you have experienced elsewhere, although we use the best of what is available locally. Please note, this itinerary is subject to weather and river conditions. The Captain/Cruise Director reserves the right to adjust the itinerary for passenger safety and comfort. The Brahmaputra River is subject to seasonal fluctuations. Islands and sand bars can appear and disappear between one sailing and the next. Also, being one of the highest precipitation zones in the world, our program is subject to weather and River conditions.
