SCENIC CRUISING THE FJORDS

Take in Norway's inspiring landscapes from the comfort of your ship. Glide along size-restricted waterways flanked by towering cliffs; experience seasonal delights such as the first blooms of spring or the fruit-laden orchards of autumn; and enjoy special diversions along the likes of Maurangerfjord, home to the cascading Fureberg Waterfall.

OLDEN

You're never far from an eye-catching sight during a day in Olden. The village itself is set among lush green meadows and towering cliffs, while nearby are the awe-inspiring Briksdal Glacier – which can be reached via troll car or hike – and the Loen Skylift, presenting panoramic views over Nordfjord.

A maiden port for Fred. Olsen, Leirvik is a great example of a hidden gem that's off the beaten track. Among the highlights of the area is the Siggjo summit – a fabulous viewpoint and an exciting geological area with well-preserved volcanic rocks.

Located at the mouth of the Rauma River, encircled by snow-capped peaks, Åndalsnes is nestled in one of Norway's most scenic areas. As such, it provides an ideal starting point for forest walks as well as hikes to iconic viewpoints like Rampestreken.
