We recommend that you also take your passport for identification purposes when taking domestic flights. To meet Border Force security check requirements, Saga Cruises require certain passport information from you and your party in advance of your departure date. We will ask for this information at the time of booking. A failure to provide the passport information prior to your departure date may result in you and your party being denied boarding. If you or a member of your party are denied boarding in these circumstances, this will be treated as a cancellation.

Visas and ETAs: Unless we advise you otherwise at the time of booking, your specific passport and visa requirements, and other immigration requirements are your responsibility, and you should confirm these with the relevant Embassies and/or Consulates. We do not accept any responsibility if you cannot travel because you have not complied with any passport, visa or immigration requirements.

Refusal to complete our questionnaire or comply with our health screening requirements may result in you being denied boarding.
