SPIRIT OF THE RHINE

A warm welcome aboard



Our very first purpose-built boutique river cruise ship, Spirit of the Rhine was designed with our guests in mind. Following the success of her inaugural season a few years ago, she became the blueprint for her sister ships that followed.

Spirit of the Rhine's unique decor

Each of our boutique river cruise ships has her own identity, inspired by the river she is named after. Spirit of the Rhine's interior design features soft blue hues with pastel pink highlights throughout, and focuses on the river's legends, such as Lorelei and Rheinfels Castle. A specially commissioned piece depicting the castle, painted by Sunga Park is exhibited in Rheinfels Restaurant. In the Lorelei Lounge you can see a 3D depiction of butterflies landing on 'the Lorelei book' by Lisa Haftel, while the ship's corridors showcase delicate butterfly wing patterns by Lauri Dunn.

Lorelei Lounge

Featuring floor-to-ceiling windows throughout, the Lorelei Lounge is the heart of the ship, and the perfect place to socialise with fellow guests in the bar, read a book with a cup of coffee from the self-serve tea and coffee station, or pull up a chair and enjoy the changing scenery as you cruise. The ship has an extensive Sun Deck, complete with sun loungers, waiter-served drinks and a plunge pool.

Choose your cabin

More than 75% of the ship's 92 cabins have French balconies, looking out from the Middle and Upper decks. With floor-to-ceiling windows, they offer great views as you are sailing. Cabins on the Lower deck are smaller and feature a small picture window, so they also have plenty of natural light. All are equipped with a flat-screen television, a Bluetooth speaker with USB, tea and coffee-making facilities, a small fridge, hairdryer, telephone, safe, seating area, bathrobes and slippers.



Dine in the Panorama Restaurant

The Panorama restaurant is the main dining spot aboard each of our boutique ships and serves up a tempting buffet at breakfast and lunch, along with waiter-served fine dining in the evening against the backdrop of views of the riverside scenery.

Rheinfels: the speciality restaurant

For special occasions, or a more intimate atmosphere, the smaller speciality restaurant on board is a great choice. It is free to dine in, however, booking is required once you are on board to reserve your place.

Spirit of the Danube joined our fleet in 2022, and like her sister ship, provides a stylish and relaxing way to visit some of Europe's great riverside cities.

Spirit of the Danube's elegant decor

The interior design features Art Nouveau style in pink and green hues and a Danube Delta wildlife theme, with designs incorporating migratory birds throughout. The elegant lobby features a stunning mosaic representing the river and the places of interest that run along it created by artist Ann Bubis. While the ship's corridors showcase hand-cut paper artworks by Andrew Malon.

Belvedere Lounge

Providing a bright and sociable space to relax, socialise and enjoy activities, such as crafts or talks (depending on your cruise), the Belvedere Lounge is the hub of the ship, featuring a bar, tea and coffee area, library and plenty of seating by the floor-to-ceiling windows so you can take in the views as you head to your next port of call. The ship also features a Sun Deck, where you can enjoy the fresh air as you cruise.

Boutique cabins

Waking up to a different view when sailing is just one of the joys of river cruising, which is why our cabins on the Middle and Upper Decks all have French balconies, while the smaller lower-deck cabins have small picture windows. All cabins include a flat-screen television, Bluetooth speaker with USB, telephone, safe, seating area, tea and coffee-making facilities, as well as bathrobes and slippers.

Spirit of the Danube features two restaurants, with the main restaurant being the Panorama Restaurant. Like all our Spirit-class boutique ships, the restaurant provides a variety of dining choices on the menu, which you can enjoy with a riverside view thanks to the floor-to-ceiling windows.

Spirit of the Danube's speciality restaurant provides an intimate dining experience – perfect for a special occasion during your cruise. You will need to book your table once on board, but dining in this restaurant is included in the price.

Our newest boutique river ship launched in the summer of 2025. Step aboard next year and enjoy the latest addition to our fleet as she sails on the river she was named after, the Moselle, which is reflected in the ship's modern and creative interior design.

Designed for you

Taking similar design cues from her sister ships, Spirit of the Moselle celebrates the river she is named after, with nods to the rich architecture and foliage of the wine towns in the region. Inspiration is drawn from a painting by English artist JMW Turner, Beilstein and Burg Metternich, with accent colours of rich reds, greens and golds featuring throughout the ship. The ship's main deck features floor-to-ceiling windows, bathing the ship in light throughout, and allowing the ever-changing scenery to complement the ship as it winds along the Main and Moselle.

The Lounge

To maximise the space on board, the lounge comprises three distinct areas. The main bar is the social hub of the ship, while a self-service tea and coffee station provides a quieter social area that is reminiscent of a French café. The inviting library area of the lounge is perfect for relaxing with a good book.

A choice of cabins

The ship's 92 boutique cabins are the perfect place to relax after a day exploring. Waking up to a different view when sailing is just one of the joys of river cruising, which is why our cabins on the Middle and Upper Decks all have French balconies, while the smaller lower-deck cabins have small windows.



The Panorama Restaurant

The ship's main restaurant serves buffet breakfasts and lunches, with waiter-served fine dining in the evening. The large windows mean you can enjoy stunning riverside views as you dine.

Beilstein: the speciality restaurant

A more intimate speciality dining restaurant, Beilstein, meaning 'Sleeping Beauty of the Moselle', is perfect for special occasions, and free to dine in during your cruise. Booking is required once you are on board.

SAIL THE SCENIC MOSELLE

Showcase included excursions

MELK ABBEY TOUR

Explore and look around one of the Danube's most famous baroque buildings. Set on a rocky outcrop, the abbey was first founded in 1089 and is now famed for its monastic school and library. Tour the Benedictine monastery with a guide, seeing the church frescoes, marble hall and of course, the world-famous library housing more than 80,000 books. Next enjoy time to explore independently, perhaps walking through the abbey gardens. **See pages 39, 40, 42 and 45.**





TRIER CITY GUIDED WALK

Hop off the ship and join an expert local guide for a walking tour around Trier's inner-city, the best way to see the sights. Pass along the banks of the Moselle to see the ancient Roman Bridge, then explore further with a guided tour on foot to several UNESCO World Heritage Sites including the Porta Nigra, market square, cathedral and Church of Our Lady. **See pages 24, 30, 34 and 36.**



DRACHENFELS COG RAILWAY RIDE

Step aboard the Drachenfelsbahn – Germany's oldest rack and pinion railway, dating back to 1883. This scenic journey reaches a peak of nearly 1,000 feet at the summit of Drachenfels Mountain. Enjoy a talk from your guide about this area, the rail and its history. You will then have some free time to view the ruins of 12th-century Drachenfel Castle from the top with its sweeping panoramic views. **See pages 18, 19, 24 and 34.**

Along with your included and optional excursions, there are plenty of other ways to see the sights, your way.

Our free transfer bus

Most of the time, our ships are moored close to the main sights, making it easy to disembark and walk into the city or town and start exploring straight away. But whenever you are a little further away, we will provide a complimentary transfer bus. You can use this to head into the main town and explore.

Interactive maps and headsets

In selected ports, you can also borrow our free interactive maps and audio headsets, perfect for exploring independently. These devices make it easy to go on your own mini-adventure in and around the town, following routes to the local monuments and other landmarks. Our crew will happily show you how to use them when you are on board.

Enriching entertainment on board

The time you spend aboard our river ships is just as interesting as your days exploring the riverside destinations. Our resident on-board entertainer will now be joined by a new Enrichment Host, who will provide a number of day time activities, along with more on-board entertainment from local musicians and performers.

This includes live music from a string quartet in Belgrade, demonstrations of Hungarian folklore, plus there will be a host of lectures to help understand the culture and history of the destinations you are visiting.

Keukenhof Gardens and Highlights of Holland

Cruise the charming Dutch waterways in spring, when the tulip fields are beginning to bloom. Enjoy a walking tour of Dordrecht to see the historic City Hall and the statue of the De Witt brothers, among other attractions. Sail overnight to arrive early in the city of Arnhem. From here an excursion visits the De Hoge Veluwe National Park and the Kröller-Müller Museum. The museum houses over 180 drawings and nearly 90 paintings by Vincent Van Gogh, and also features a sculpture garden.

Continue to Zaandam, where an excursion visits Keukenhof Gardens to discover its world-famous floral displays independently. This is the perfect time of year to visit what has been described as, 'the most beautiful spring garden in the world!'. In Amsterdam, look forward to a cruise along the city's iconic canals, passing historic bridges, gabled buildings and countless bicycles.

Lake IJssel and Keukenhof Gardens

Discover the attractions of the Dutch waterways and the IJssel Lake. Enjoy a leisurely morning cruise from Rotterdam to Utrecht. From here you can visit Castle De Haar to learn more about the flamboyant, 20th-century lifestyle of the Van Zuylen family by exploring the castle and grounds independently. From Zaandam, look forward to spending the day at leisure in the world-famous Keukenhof Gardens, where you can browse their renowned spring floral displays independently. Continue to Amsterdam, the lively capital of the Netherlands, and enjoy a journey aboard one of its glass-topped canal boats past gabled houses and historic bridges. Cruise the IJssel Lake to Enkhuizen, one of the Dutch East India Company's main ports

in the 17th century. Browse the Zuiderzee Museum, which exhibits over 140 historic buildings from villages around the former Zuiderzee. Beside the Marker Lake, visit Lelystad, which is built on reclaimed land. Head to Giethoorn, where an excursion by canal cruiser will reveal the distinctive thatched houses that line the village's network of canals. Your cruise concludes in the city of Rotterdam, home to an array of modern architecture and sculptures. See more of the city by coach, stopping for a walking tour of the historic Delfshaven district, with its traditional gabled buildings, the Cube Houses and the Markthal, a combined indoor food market and apartment block.

PAYING FOR YOUR CRUISE

Deposits: When you make your booking, you must a deposit of £250 per person or 15% of the cruise cost, whichever is the greater.

Balance: The balance of the price of your travel arrangements must be paid at least 90 days before departure. Unless you are otherwise advised, bookings made after the balance due date (as set out above) must be paid in full at the time of booking and we cannot confirm your booking until full payment is received. Payments can be made by credit card, debit card or cheque. If the deposit and/or balance is not paid in time, we reserve the right to cancel your travel arrangements. If the balance is not paid in time, we shall retain your deposit to cover costs incurred.

Payment methods: All deposits and balances to be made to your travel agent by their accepted forms of payment within the times frames as stated opposite.

Your financial protection and peace of mind: Some of the flights and flight-inclusive cruises in this brochure are financially protected by the ATOL scheme. But ATOL protection does not apply to all holiday and travel services listed in this brochure. If you do not receive an ATOL Certificate then the booking will not be ATOL protected. If you do receive an ATOL Certificate but all the parts of your trip are not listed on it, those parts will not be ATOL protected. BEFORE YOU TRAVEL

Passports: You will need a valid passport for all cruises featured. As requirements vary and can change without notice, we strongly advise you to ensure that your passport is valid for at least six months after the end of your cruise. We recommend that you have at least three blank pages in your passport to cover potential immigration formalities, which may be required in some countries. We recommend that you also take your passport for identification purposes when taking domestic flights. To meet Border Force security check requirements, Saga requires certain passport information from you and your party in advance of your departure date. We will ask for this information at the time of booking. A failure to provide the passport information prior to your departure date may result in you and your party being denied boarding. If you or a member of your party are denied boarding in these circumstances, this will be treated as a cancellation.

Visas and ETAs: Unless we advise you otherwise at the time of booking, your specific passport and visa requirements, and other immigration requirements are your responsibility, and you should confirm these with the relevant Embassies and/or Consulates. We do not accept any responsibility if you cannot travel because you have not complied with any passport, visa or immigration requirements.

From 2025 it is expected that a full British citizen resident in the UK will need an ETIAS travel authorisation in order to enter most EU member states. You will be responsible for obtaining this authorisation before travel and you are also responsible for ensuring that you do not breach

any restrictions governing your length of stay in these countries. If you are a British citizen resident in the UK, you may wish to refer to government advice at <https://www.gov.uk/browse/abroad>. Travel advice: The Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office (FCDO) Travel Advice Unit provides up-to-date advice and safety information for British nationals travelling abroad. Health screening: We will require you to complete our pre-boarding health questionnaire, comply with any of our health screening requirements (including, without limitation, mandatory testing for COVID-19) and to supply full and accurate information of any symptoms of or positive tests for viral or bacterial illness you or a member of your party may have including, without limitation, COVID-19. We also require you to inform us of any recent close contact you or any member of your party may have had with someone suspected of or known to have a viral or bacterial illness including, without limitation, COVID-19. Refusal to complete our questionnaire or comply with our health screening requirements may result in you being denied boarding. If you are denied boarding in any of these circumstances, this will be treated as a cancellation by you and cancellation charges may apply.

Further, to avoid the spread of any viral or bacterial illness on board including, without limitation, COVID-19, we may deny boarding to any passenger who displays symptoms of any such illness or who in our reasonable opinion may be at risk of having contracted any such illness. If you are denied boarding in these circumstances, you will not be entitled to a refund but you may amend your cruise to a different date.

COVID-19 vaccinations: We recommend that all passengers are vaccinated and boosted against COVID-19 using a COVID-19 vaccine approved by the UK's Medical and Healthcare Regulatory Authority.

Other vaccinations: We will advise you with your holiday confirmation of any other vaccinations that are required as a condition of entry to the country(ies) that you are visiting. We recommend that you consult your doctor at least 12 weeks before departure, and they will advise you about any other vaccinations required. You may also wish to refer to government health advice for your destination at [gov.uk/foreign-travel-advice](https://www.gov.uk/foreign-travel-advice).

Mobility and assistance: None of our river cruise ships have cabins adapted for use by those with restricted mobility, and the use of wheelchairs onboard is not permitted.

We reserve the right to refuse the carriage of any person if carrying such a passenger would breach applicable safety requirements

or law. We also reserve the right to refuse carriage if the design of the vessel and/or the port infrastructure and equipment would make carriage unsafe or not operationally feasible. We reserve the right to require that a disabled passenger or a passenger of reduced mobility is accompanied by another fare paying person capable of providing assistance to ensure compliance with any applicable safety requirement or law or if the design of the vessel and/or the port infrastructure and equipment means that a disabled passenger or person of reduced mobility cannot be carried in a safe or operationally feasible manner without the assistance of another person. **Please advise us at the time of booking if you or any member of your party has reduced mobility or would require assistance in an emergency, or as soon as possible before departure should there be a change in circumstances. If you do not inform us of such a condition we will not be liable if any airline (where applicable) refuses to accept you or any member of your party as a passenger.** If you are disabled or have difficulty moving around, you are legally entitled to receive assistance when you fly. This free service is available to anyone with mobility problems, for example, because of your disability, age or a temporary injury. To take full advantage of the service you need to book at least 48 hours in advance of your flight. Please contact us as soon as possible prior to departure. Food allergies or specific dietary requirements on board the ship:

If you've got any food allergies or specific dietary requirements, it is important that you advise us at the time of booking. It is also essential that you make the maître d' aware of your allergies or dietary requirements after arriving on board and ask for information about ingredients before eating. Cruise guests are also reminded that any required medications should be kept with them at all times.

ON BOARD

Changes to the itinerary: The weather can affect river levels and sometimes this impacts on an itinerary. In the unlikely event of this happening we will do our utmost to ensure the cruise remains as close to its original itinerary as possible or we will offer a suitable alternative if necessary. It is also sometimes necessary to close the outside deck when cruising through sections of river with very low bridges for safety reasons.

Berthing arrangements: At some of the more popular ports you may find your ship berths alongside other river cruise ships, which means the views from the windows can become obscured and you may have to walk across other ships to reach the riverbank. On rare occasions the berth will be located on the outskirts of town, a decision which is beyond our control and often made by the river authorities at that port. In these circumstances, and where there is no included excursion operating, we will arrange complimentary shuttle bus service.

Health and Safety procedures: We have developed stringent procedures for dealing with viral or bacterial illnesses in relation to our cruises. These procedures may mean that some facilities and services may not be available during the cruise package. The procedures may also change at short notice depending on the circumstances and latest advice and guidance available in respect of the particular illness. Any procedures introduced to prevent or limit the spread of viral or bacterial illnesses will not be a significant change to your cruise package. You are required to follow our instructions or those of the Master or the ship's crew in respect of any procedures designed to prevent or limit the spread of viral or bacterial illnesses. This may include the mandatory wearing of face masks in all public areas. If you fail to comply with our procedures or our instructions or those of the ship's Master or crew or your health or conduct is likely to endanger the health and safety of other passengers or crew, we and/or the ship's master reserve the right to take reasonable and appropriate action which could include the curtailment of your cruise package. In such circumstances, no compensation or refund will be payable and, in the event of curtailment, you will be liable to pay any additional expenses reasonably incurred in arranging the curtailment.
