### Day 1 : PUNTA ARENAS

Boarding at 6:00 PM. Welcome toast and introduction of the Captain and crew. Afterwards, the ship will set sail for the far south, through the legendary Strait of Magellan into the Beagle Channel, exploring Patagonia and Tierra del Fuego.

### Day 2 : AINSWORTH BAY - BROOKES GLACIER

At first light, we will sail through Admiralty Sound to the vicinity of the Marinelli Glacier in Ainsworth Bay. We will learn how life re-emerges after the retreat of the ice. We will embark on a hike to discover a beaver dam and the magnificent sub-Antarctic Magellanic forest that surrounds it. Resuming our voyage, the ship will head towards the Brookes Glacier. This glacier exhibits remarkable activity, and its growth regularly causes the calving of small blocks of ice.

### Day 3 : CARLOS III ISLAND

Throughout the morning, the Stella Australis will sail through the Strait of Magellan to Carlos III Island, home to the Francisco Coloane Marine Park, a protected area for scientific research and ideal for humpback whale watching. State-of-the-art equipment will be available for observers to witness the magnificence of these marine mammals.

### Day 4 : CONDOR AND AGUILA GLACIERS

In the morning, we will navigate the Cockburn Channel to enter Agostini Sound, where we will be able to appreciate the glaciers that descend from the center of the Darwin Range, some reaching the sea. Later in the morning, we will disembark in Zodiac boats for a leisurely hike around a lagoon formed by the meltwater of the Aguila Glacier, which we will eventually come face to face with. In the afternoon, we will take another Zodiac boat trip to approach the Condor Glacier. We will learn about the formation of glaciers and their influence on the rugged geography of the Fuegian channels.

### Day 5 : GARIBALDI GLACIER - PÍA GLACIER - GLACIER ALLEY

Early in the morning, after passing through the Canal Ballanero the ship will enter Garibaldi Fjord. We will sail through the Northwest arm of the Beagle Channel to enter and disembark at Pía Fjord. We will take an excursion to the viewpoint from where we can observe the glacier of the same name, whose main tongue extends from the top of the mountain range to the sea. After this unforgettable experience, we will continue our voyage under the majestic gaze of the "Glacier Alley".

### Day 6 : CAPE HORN - WULAIYA BAY


Arrival at Cape Horn National Park and disembarkation (weather permitting). This mythical, almost vertical promontory, 425 meters high, was discovered in 1616. It is a formidable passage on the maritime route between the Pacific and Atlantic Oceans. Known as the "end of the world," it was declared a World Biosphere Reserve in 2005. In the afternoon, explore Wulaia Bay, one of the key settlements of the indigenous Yámana people, who lived in canoes. Charles Darwin traveled to this place aboard the HMS Beagle on January 23, 1833. The area offers a breathtaking visual spectacle thanks to its vegetation and geography. The hike leads to a magnificent viewpoint, winding through a Magellanic forest where lenga trees (Tierra del Fuego beech), coigüe trees, canelo trees, and ferns, among other species, thrive.

### Day 7 : PUERTO TORO - PUERTO WILLIAMS

Embark in the morning at Puerto Toro to meet the inhabitants of this small fishing village of fewer than 20 people, considered the southernmost in the world. In the afternoon, explore the community of Puerto Williams and visit the small museum that showcases the last descendants of the Yaghan people.

### Day 8 : USHUAIA (ARGENTINA)

Arrive in Ushuaia, an Argentinian city, the highest point in Tierra del Fuego and the southernmost city in the world. Disembark at 8:30 a.m.
