



14 DAYS | CAPE TOWN TO JOHANNESBURG


Step into the pages of National Geographic and explore its 135+ year legacy in South Africa, Zimbabwe, and Botswana. Traverse diverse landscapes, from Cape Town's storied coast and the wild expanses of Greater Kruger to thundering Victoria Falls and the Chobe River – home to the highest concentration of elephants on Earth. Connect with the ancient culture of the San people, trace Mandela's legacy, and witness iconic wildlife with conservation experts who bring the living story of the land to life.

HIGHLIGHTS

Hear intimate tales of friendship from former guard Christo Brand about Mandela's final years at Victor Verster Prison.

Sleep suspended over the Sabie River in a restored train carriage at Kruger Shalati, watching wildlife roam below.

Frame the perfect wildlife shot on the Chobe River with real-time advice and technical tips from expert photographers.



DAYS 1-4: CAPE TOWN & THE COAST

Arrive in Cape Town and settle in with views of Table Mountain. Immerse yourself in the origins of the San people at !Kwa ttu and savour award-winning wines in the Darling Hills. Ascend Table Mountain by cable car, cook Cape Malay dishes in Bo-Kaap, and hear personal stories of Mandela from his former guard. Explore the dramatic Cape Peninsula, visiting the Cape of Good Hope and the penguin colony at Boulders Beach before enjoying a free evening in the city.

DAYS 5-9: JOHANNESBURG & GREATER KRUGER

Continue to Johannesburg to tour the Apartheid Museum and Mandela Foundation, gaining profound historical context. Journey onward to the Greater Kruger area for a Signature conservation talk with the Endangered Wildlife Trust. Embark on safari drives to spot the Big Five and stay in the remarkable Train on the Bridge lodge suspended over the Sabie River. Connect with local culture at the Shabalala Centre and enjoy a private bush dinner under the stars, surrounded by the sounds of the wilderness.


DAYS 10-15: VICTORIA FALLS & CHOBE NATIONAL PARK

Travel north to Victoria Falls to witness the power of the 'Smoke that Thunders.' Visit a women's cooperative for a cooking demonstration and cruise the Zambezi at sunset. Cross into Botswana for a stay on the Chobe River. Join professional photographers for a dedicated photo-safari cruise, capturing elephants and hippos in golden light. Explore Chobe National Park on game drives before a farewell dinner celebrating your journey across Southern Africa, then return to Johannesburg for departure.



G FOR GOOD MOMENT

Share a traditional lunch and cooking demo with the women of the Lusumpuko Club. Then, engage with a Victoria Falls Wildlife Trust expert to learn about their critical work rescuing and rehabilitating wildlife in the region.

Connect with the San, Earth's first people – a lineage long celebrated in National Geographic's study of human origins. Through immersive storytelling and tasting ancestral foods, gain deep insight into the wisdom of humanity's oldest living culture.

SIGNATURE: THE FIVE STANS & THE HEART OF THE SILK ROAD

19 DAYS | BISHKEK TO ASHGABAT

Trace the legends of the Silk Road across five nations, exploring a region long chronicled by National Geographic. From the snow-capped Tian Shan mountains to the monuments of Tashkent, connect with the living soul of Central Asia. Experience exclusive museum access, encounter ancient nomadic traditions, and tour top-secret science facilities on an expedition defined by deep discovery.

HIGHLIGHTS


Join an archaeologist at Tajikistan's National Museum to unearth the region's deep Buddhist roots and ancient artifacts.

SIGNATURE: CHINA'S GREAT WALL, XI'AN & THE GOBI DESERT

10 DAYS | BEIJING TO CHENGDU

Explore the Middle Kingdom through the lens of National Geographic's long history in China. From Beijing's imperial treasures to the Gobi's sweeping dunes, dine atop the Great Wall at sunset and go behind the scenes with archaeologists in Xi'an. End among Chengdu's pandas, discovering a land where history is etched into every landscape.



HIGHLIGHTS

Watch Mingsha's dunes turn gold at sunset from the Crescent Spring oasis, accompanied by tales of the ancient Silk Road.

Explore Xi'an's Muslim Quarter and uncover the rich history and living traditions of its Hui Muslim community.

Savour regional dishes at a dinner atop the Great Wall, as the surrounding peaks soften and glow in the evening light.

SIGNATURE MOMENT

With special National Geographic access, go behind closed doors at the Shaanxi Provincial Institute of Archaeology. Enter restricted labs to examine recently unearthed antiquities alongside an expert, witnessing the delicate preservation work that keeps history alive.

SIGNATURE: PALAU'S ROCK ISLANDS & UNDERWATER SERENGETI

9 DAYS | KOROR

Voyage into the emerald maze of the Rock Islands, where the ocean is a living wilderness. Your expedition flows from the silence of mangrove forests to the teeming drop-offs of an underwater Serengeti, as chronicled by National Geographic's Pristine Seas Expedition. Alongside researchers and elders, bridge the gap between ancient tradition and modern conservation, discovering the soul of this pristine archipelago.



HIGHLIGHTS

Snorkel over the ghostly silhouette of a submerged Japanese fighter plane resting in the crystal shallows.

Connect with the living memory of the islands as a revered elder shares ancestral stories at the National Museum.

Engage in hands-on conservation on Ulong Island, planting young clams to help revitalize the native reef population.

Step into the Coral Reef Research Foundation to uncover the ocean's medical mysteries. Meet a researcher to learn how rare invertebrates from hidden marine lakes hold potential cancer cures, revealing the life-saving power of Palau's biodiversity.

SIGNATURE: ICONIC TRAINS OF SWITZERLAND & ITALY'S LAKE DISTRICT

10 DAYS | ZURICH TO LAGO MAGGIORE

Traverse the majestic Swiss Alps and Italian Lakes by rail, tracing routes that have long captivated National Geographic storytellers. Glide past snow-capped peaks to discover villages shaped by mountain ingenuity – and the flavours born from it. Savour authentic fondue and world-class chocolate, wander historic villas on Lake Maggiore, and immerse yourself in the culture of this Alpine wonderland.

HIGHLIGHTS

Traverse the alps aboard the legendary Glacier Express, crossing 291 bridges on one of the world's most spectacular rail journeys.

Step inside the medieval walls of the Rocca di Angera castle for a private fresh pasta masterclass, culminating with a regional wine tasting.

Explore the intersection of nature and canvas during a curated tour of the Segantini Museum, gaining deep insight into Alpine art.
