



By way of comparison, the most powerful ships are classified as PC1, and there are no passenger ships of this kind. You thus benefit... from sailing in multi-year ice, inaccessible to other ships, for much of the year.

2 EXCLUSIVITY, EXPERTISE AND IMMERSION

Le Commandant Charcot is the world's only passenger ship... to take you to the North Pole and the remote coasts of Spitsbergen and Greenland at the end of winter. You thus benefit... a true immersion in the heart of inaccessible territories, between ice and icebergs, thanks to a host of activities - dog sledding, snowshoe hiking, ice fishing, kayaking, meetings with local communities - supervised by local guides or the team of naturalist guides who are experts in the destination.

3 AN INVISIBLE FRONTIER

Le Commandant Charcot is the world's only passenger ship... to offer staterooms and suites, all with balconies or terraces, and common areas that are largely open to the outside, all a guarantee of the highest level of comfort and safety in the polar environment. You thus benefit... from a total connection with the grandiose surrounding landscapes, from every part of the ship, including the spa, the indoor pool or the various lounges and restaurants.

4 GASTRONOMY BY ALAIN DUCASSE

Le Commandant Charcot is the world's only passenger ship... to offer Alain Ducasse's cuisine at sea, and in such isolated regions, in the gastronomic restaurant *le Nuna* (the Earth, in Inuit). You thus benefit... from a menu devised by the Michelin-starred chef, as well as some of his signature dishes, while enjoying refined tableware that attains a level of excellence unrivalled in the polar regions.

5 MORE RESPECTFUL SAILINGS

Le Commandant Charcot is the world's only passenger ship... to incorporate a number of the most advanced technologies, combining electric propulsion and liquefied natural gas, aimed at reducing its environmental footprint as much as possible. It also has two research laboratories, open to international scientists, on behalf of renowned research institutes including Ifremer, GEOMAR and the Alfred Wegener Institute. You thus benefit... from an understanding, in situ, of the issues encountered in the regions visited, thanks to exchanges with researchers. The ship is *Green Globe* certified, the internationally recognised benchmark for sustainable tourism.
