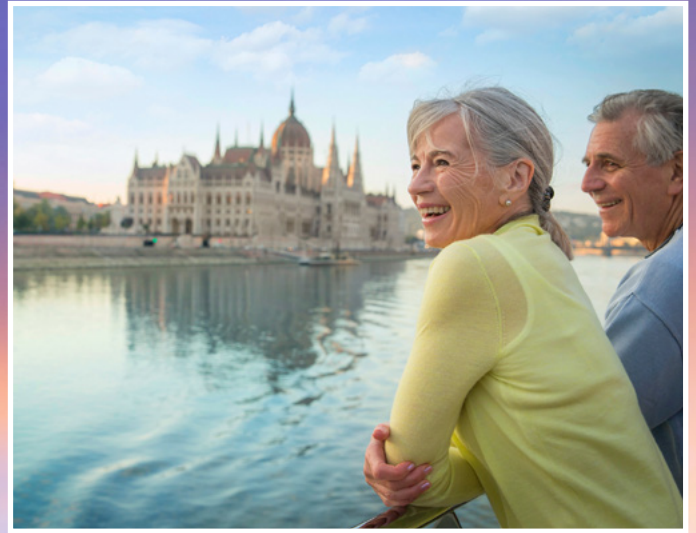

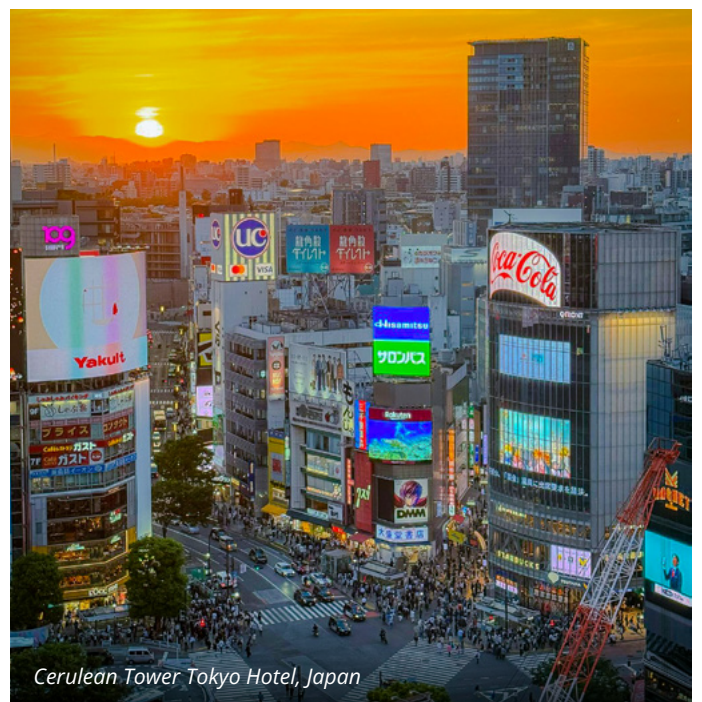

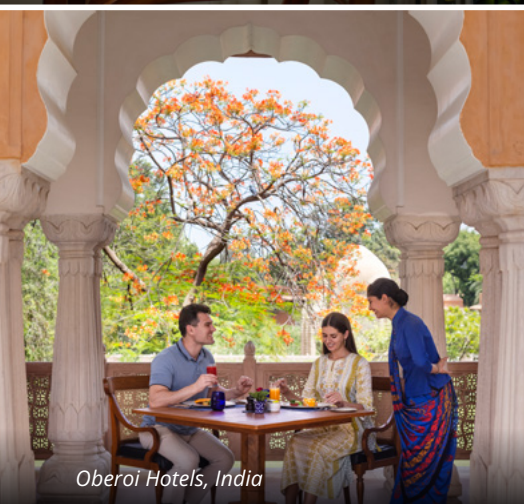

Venice to Venice

DAY 11: Tatawa Besar, Sabulon

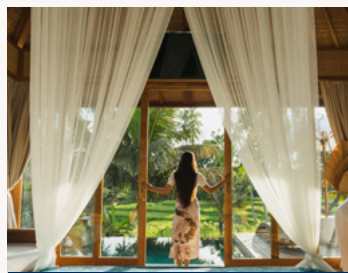

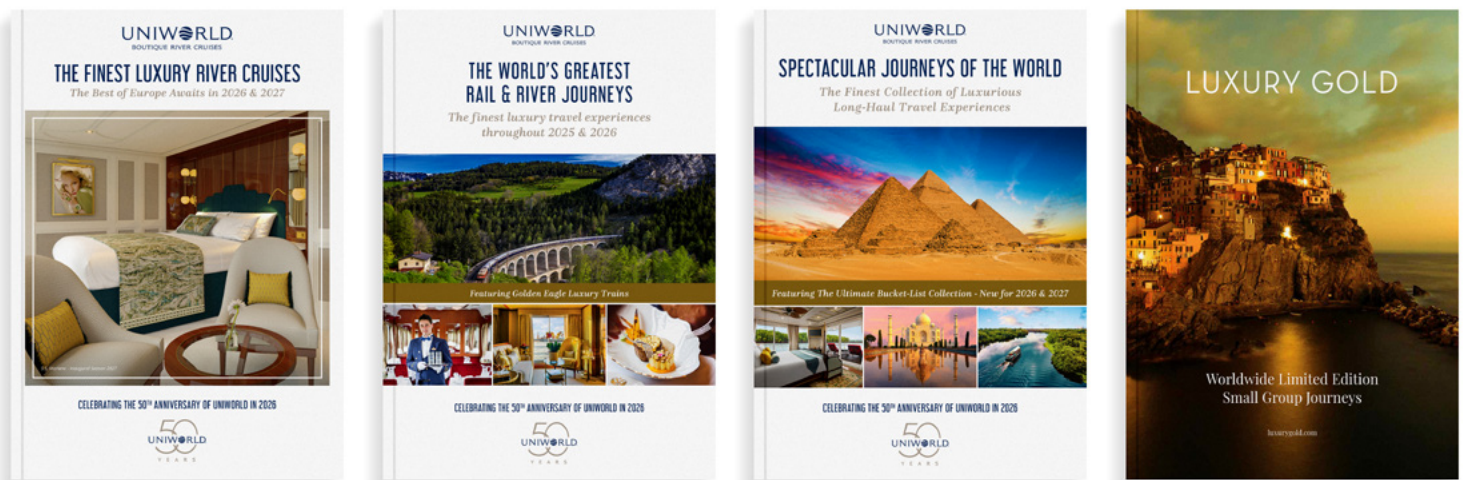
