DAY 2 – Athens

Enjoy a leisurely morning exploring Athens. Why not explore the charming district of Plaka, crammed with neo-classical mansions, balconies overflowing with geraniums and twisting cobbled lanes lined with homely tavernas? After free time for lunch, we depart for Delphi, driving north past Mt Pendeli and through Thebes, to Mt Parnassus. (B,D)

Delphi is incredible, with a unique wealth of monuments dedicated to Apollo. As we enter the sacred sanctuary, you'll see the treasuries which were filled with gold and silver donated by grateful city-states for having the benefit of the god's wisdom. The ancient Olympic Games took place every four years; the stadium had a staggering capacity of 45,000 and events included the discus and javelin, sprinting and wrestling.
