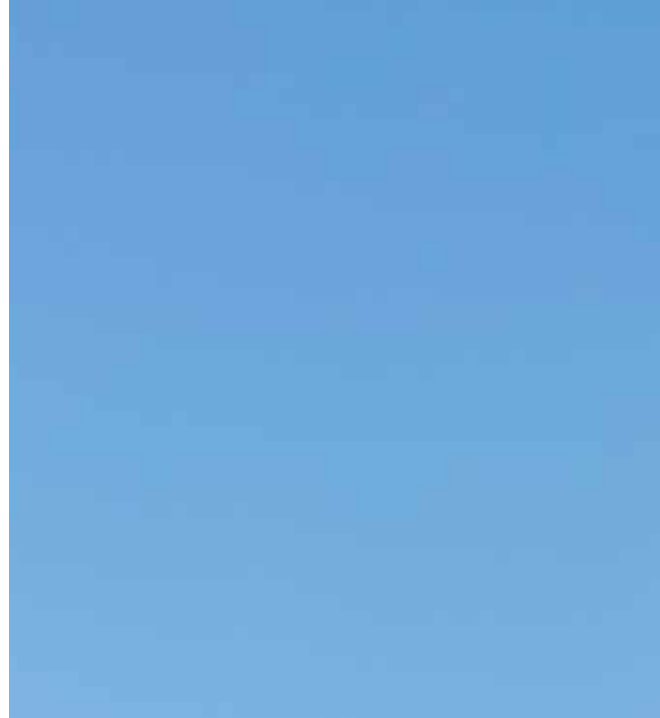

## Northeast Greenland's unexplored sea ice

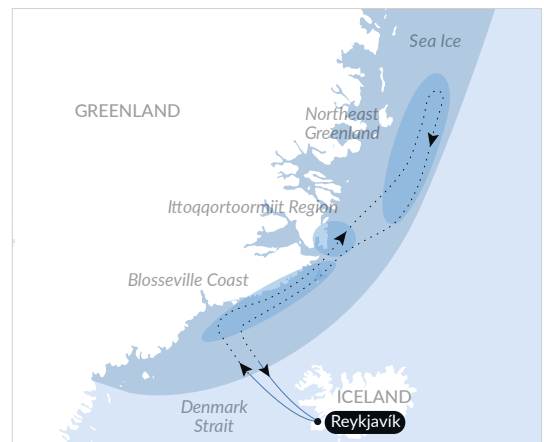

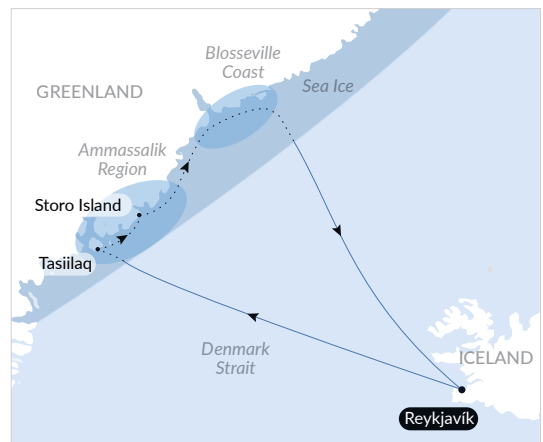
