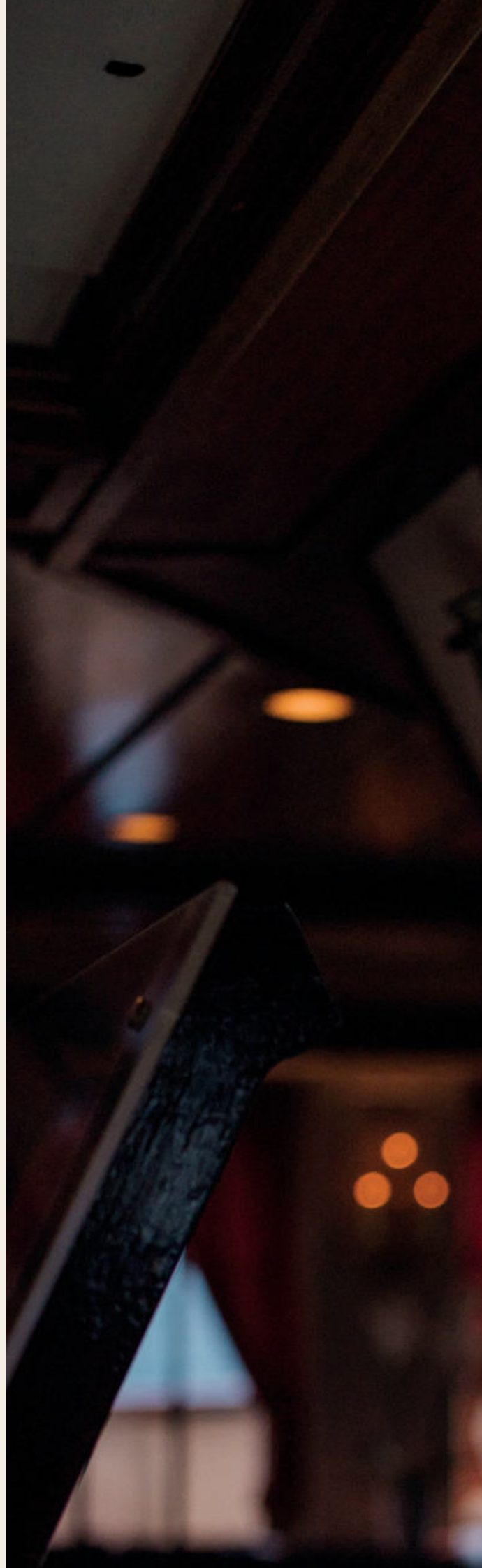
Sailing aboard *Star Clipper* feels like stepping back in time, where the modern world loosens its grip and the wind takes command. Canvas billows overhead, ropes creak with tension and the ship leans gently into the trade winds as you become part of the choreography - hauling lines, climbing the mast and breathing in the salt-rich air of a bygone maritime era.

Your tall-ship adventure begins in *St John's*, where pastel buildings and church spires rise above a bright, bustling harbour. As *Star Clipper* unfurls her sails to the tones of Vangelis' *Conquest Of Paradise*, slipping past the island's atmospheric coastline, an adventure of a lifetime begins.

In *Terre-de-Haut* in *Îles des Saintes*, *Star Clipper* glides into one of the *Caribbean's* most perfect natural harbours. Red-roofed houses cascade down to the turquoise water, cafés bustle with life and *Fort Napoléon* watches serenely from above. Time slows here, matching the unhurried rhythm of sail in perfect harmony. *Dominica's Cabrits* awaits, where rainforest-clad hills press close, waterfalls tumble with both power and grace, and the air feels alive. Anchored beneath the old British fort, *Star Clipper* seems perfectly at home – a fitting and matched parallel between land and sea. Palm trees sway in *Guadeloupe*, where *Deshaies'* bays of golden sand invite barefoot wanders and dips in the inviting ocean.

Visit the *British Virgin Islands* from *Antigua: Tortola* – the *Caribbean's* premier sailing hub - awaits, *Jost Van Dyke's* beach bars buzz and *Virgin Gorda's* dramatic granite boulders create tidal pools which dominate the horizon. Through it all, *Star Clipper* moves with grace - sails full, masts creaking softly - offering not just destinations, but a living and breathing romance with the sea.

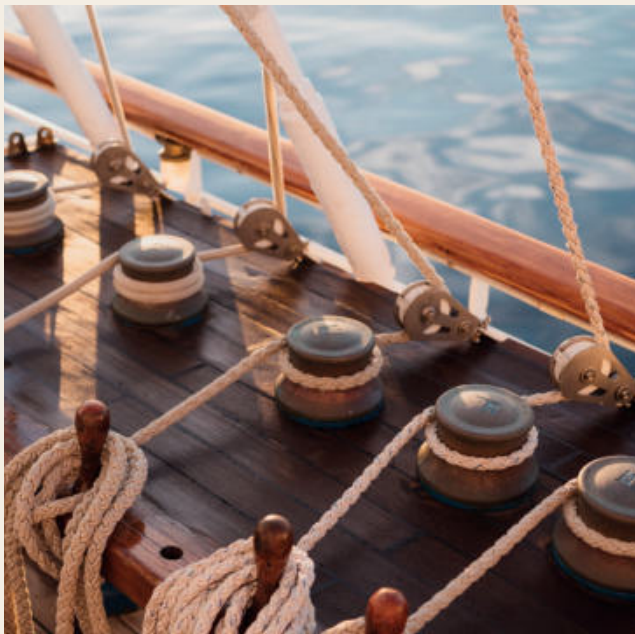
